COMPENSATORY CLASSES

9,544 children received Compensatory classes. The classes helped children at risk of dropping out of school or of achieving low educational standards to catch up their missed classes, improve their self-confidence and reach their full educational potential. The overall rate of improvement of their scores was **20.7**%.






