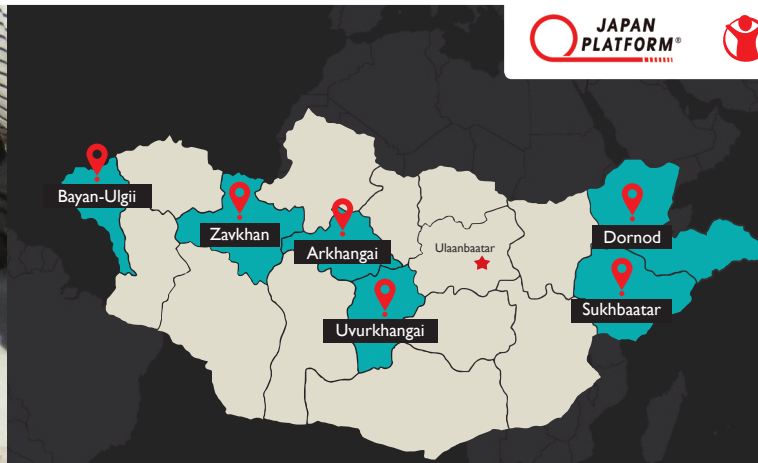

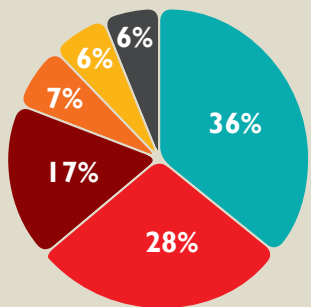

## 2 COMPENSATORY CLASSES

**9,544** children received Compensatory classes. The classes helped children at risk of dropping out of school or of achieving low educational standards to catch up their missed classes, improve their self-confidence and reach their full educational potential. The overall rate of improvement of their scores was **20.7%**.

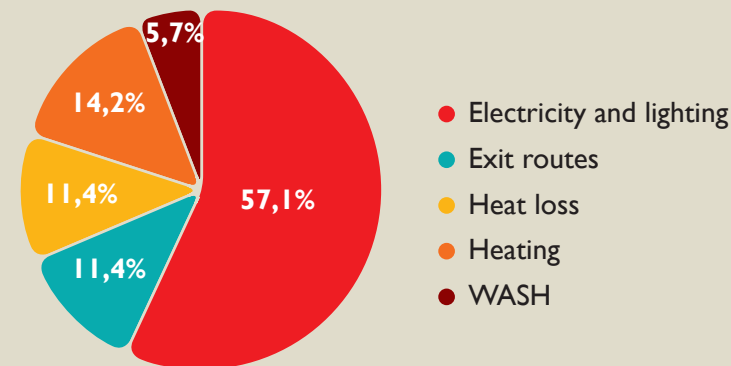
